Our **Greenhill Green Team** are making an appeal for watering cans to help us tend our gardens.

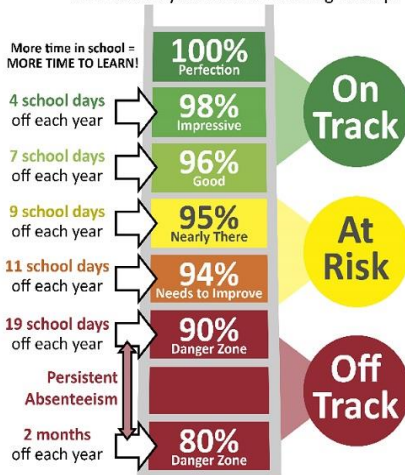
The **Green Team** will continue this term and in the next academic year and all children are welcome to join us.

It was lovely to see the children working cooperatively in their teams and supporting each other so enthusiastically.

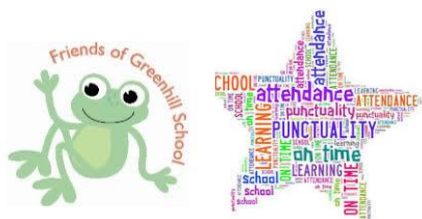
The winning house team on Sports Day was **Crompton**, but well done to all our competitors you were amazing.
