Reception Open Day

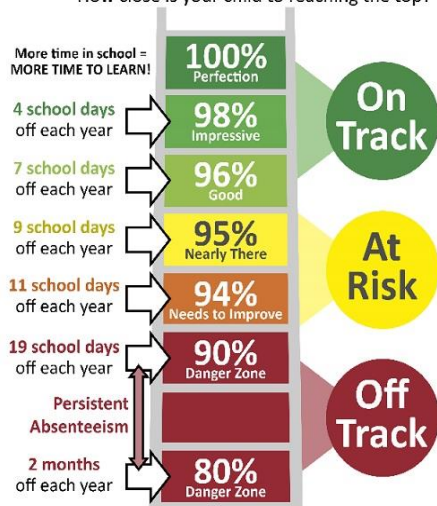
Reception Open Days
